JOB PURPOSE

To work as part of the Electroplating team undertake masking, blasting, NDT and electroplating tasks on a wide variety of aircraft components, in accordance with process specification requirements.

PRINCIPAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Across an extensive variety of components, complete electroplating processes (component stripping, aqueous cleaning, degreasing and plating) to exacting aviation quality standards and tight timeframes, to include reading and interpretation of relevant documentation, full process compliance and the safe handling of chemicals.
- To maintain the function of the plant and the equipment.
- Carry out visual inspections and achieve accurate plating thicknesses
- To assist as required with the monitoring of stock levels for chemicals and consumables.
- To assist as required with elements of machine maintenance (preventative and scheduled)
- Maintain and ensure implementation of all standard operating practices and procedures.
- Ensure strict compliance and implementation of all safety standards.
- Ensure quality standards are maintained in accordance with EASA, FAA and company procedures.
- Comply with health, safety and environmental regulations.
